


EarthCam: See Bristol Motor Speedway transform into a 150,000-seat football stadium August 29, 2016 - Mike Pryson



University of Tennessee set to play Virginia Tech on Sept. 10

The transformation of Bristol Motor Speedway from a 160,000-seat NASCAR track to a 150,000-seat college football stadium continues ahead of the scheduled Sept. 10 game between the University of Tennessee and Virginia Tech.

Organizers of the event hope to break the all-time college football attendance record of an estimated 120,000 that turned out to watch a game at Soldier Field in Chicago between Notre Dame and Southern California in 1927.
