

Watch tallest hotel in U.S. rise

On Tuesday, Marriott International officially opened the nation's tallest hotel. The 68-story, 378-room Courtyard hotel and 261-room Residence Inn occupy a 753-foot-high tower that sits at the corner of Broadway and West 54th Street. The property cost \$320 million to build.

Tech company Earthcam partnered with G Holdings, the developer and owner of the hotel, to document the 27-month construction of the tower with an HD megapixel webcam and unveiled the time-lapsed, 60-second video Thursday.
