

If You Have Two Minutes You Can Watch The Three Years It Took to Build UTSW's Clements Hospital

UT Southwestern's William P. Clements Jr. University Hospital has been open in Dallas' Medical District for about a year and a half. And EarthCam, a webcam company that's documented the construction of the 9/11 Memorial Museum as well as the Atlanta Falcon's Mercedes-Benz Stadium and the Barclay Center, has posted a two-minute time lapse of the roughly three years it took to build it.

The hospital, funded in part by a \$100 million gift by the late Texas governor it shares a name with, moved 200 patients over on December 6, 2014. It's been open since. You can watch the video below:
