Watch Houston Hobby Airport's new international terminal be built in 90 seconds

It took nearly two years to build Southwest Airlines' new international terminal at Houston Hobby Airport, but you can watch it go up in less than two minutes.

A timelapse video released by EarthCam on Thursday shows a pile of rubble transform into the sleek, glass-encased five-gate terminal over the course of 90 seconds.

Southwest footed the entire \$146 million price tag for the new terminal, which opened in October, and currently uses all five gates there for flights to Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean.
