

Not all honors in buildings and monuments to Prince in the networks are true

Not everything on the internet is actually much less on Twitter. Since the night of Thursday, 21 day of the terrible news of the death of Prince, circulated on the networks monuments pictures - The Eiffel Tower, the Empire State, Niagara Falls - lit in purple, which would be a tribute to the artist.

In fact, the Niagara Falls were lit in color in honor of the 90th anniversary of Queen Elizabeth ... coincidentally on the same day of the death of Prince . Amazing.

An image of the Empire State circulated actually date from another period. In August 2015, the building won the purple lighting in honor of the Military Order of the Purple Heart, a social organization of US war veterans.

Checks of foreign newspapers through EarthCam application on the evening of Thursday, 21, also denied pictures - false - the Eiffel Tower "painted" in purple.
