

Earthcam time-lapse video honors victims of 9/11, first responders, construction crews

Thursday marks 13 years since the September 11th attacks and in a show of solidarity, Earthcam is pausing to remember the anniversary with the release of a time-lapse video. The video honors the victims of 9/11, their families, first responders and construction crews.

The time-lapse captures the construction of the 9/11 exhibit from October 2004 to May 2014. The video also shows the Survivor Tree, which was found shortly after the attack and is a symbol of strength and resilience.

Earthcam's CEO set up the camera days after the attack. The camera and its original images have been donated to the 9/11 museum.
