

Webcam to broadcast from Warhol's grave *August 6, 2013*

PITTSBURGH -- The Andy Warhol Museum is launching a live feed from the artist's grave site in Pittsburgh to honor his upcoming birthday.

The museum said in a release that the partnership with EarthCam will go live Monday at midnight. The project is titled "Figment" because of a Warhol quote in which he said he'd like his own tombstone to be blank, or just say the word figment.

Hundreds of people visit the artist's grave every year, often leaving pop culture items such as Campbell's Soup cans or CocaCola bottles, according to the Warhol museum.

EarthCam will also have a live webcam from the church where Warhol was baptized.
