

[Time-Lapse] UT Southwestern William P. Clements Jr. University Hospital

Construction on the \$450 million UT Southwestern William P. Clements Jr. University Hospital wrapped up this May. The research and teaching hospital stands 13 stories tall and features 1,300,000 square-feet of space, 464 beds, 40,000 square-feet of emergency space and 40 emergency exam rooms.

Hunt Construction was in charge of managing the Dallas, TX based project. The finished product received tons of praise and even received a national Rising Star Quality Leadership award from the University HealthSystem Consortium for its quality and safety efforts. Francisco G. Cigarroa, Chancellor of The University of Texas System, called it, "...the largest single building ever undertaken by the UT System (\$450mm), has thus far exceeded all of our expectations."
