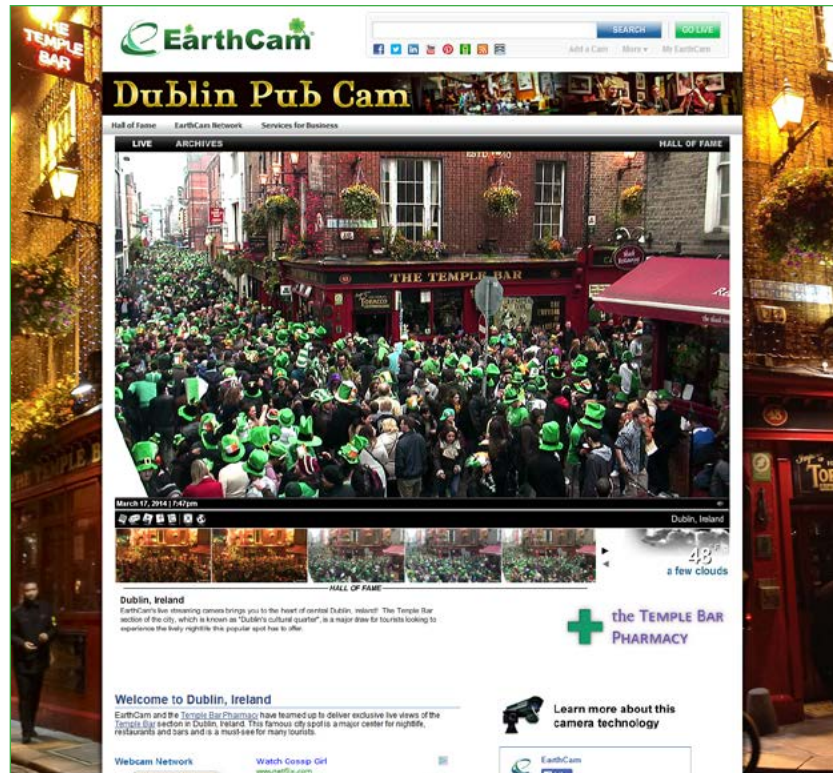
Sorry if you're reading this 18 March onwards, when it's probably back to just one or two day drinkers.
