

Video: Watch 3 Years of LAX Construction In Less Than 4 Minutes

No one said the massive overhaul of Los Angeles International Airport's Tom Bradley terminal would be quick, but thanks to this nifty time lapse video, you can see over three years' worth of its construction in less than four minutes. EarthCam's camera caught the work from April 2010 through May 2013 using high definition megapixel imagery. The final result was hand-edited to show the whole project start to finish.
