

See 39 months of construction on Kenneth F. Burns Memorial Bridge in 2 minutes with time-lapse video

WORCESTER – See the entire 39-month construction process on the new Kenneth F. Burns Memorial Bridge in two minutes thanks to a [time-lapse video](#) released by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation Wednesday.

The bridge that connects Shrewsbury and Worcester was officially opened in November 2015, four months ahead of schedule and \$5 million under the \$110 million budget.

[EarthCam's HD construction camera](#) was onsite from August 2012 to November 2015 to capture the construction of the MassDOT-funded bridge.

The former bridge was 99 years old and the new construction expanded it to include additional travel and bicycle lanes along with aesthetic features, including metal sails and under-lighting.
