

Stunning time-lapse shows 9/11 museum construction

A stunning new time-lapse video shows the construction of the 9/11 Memorial Museum.

EarthCam CEO Brian Curry and his team set up a number of webcams around the site of the World Trade Center following the terrorist attacks of Sept. 11, 2001.
