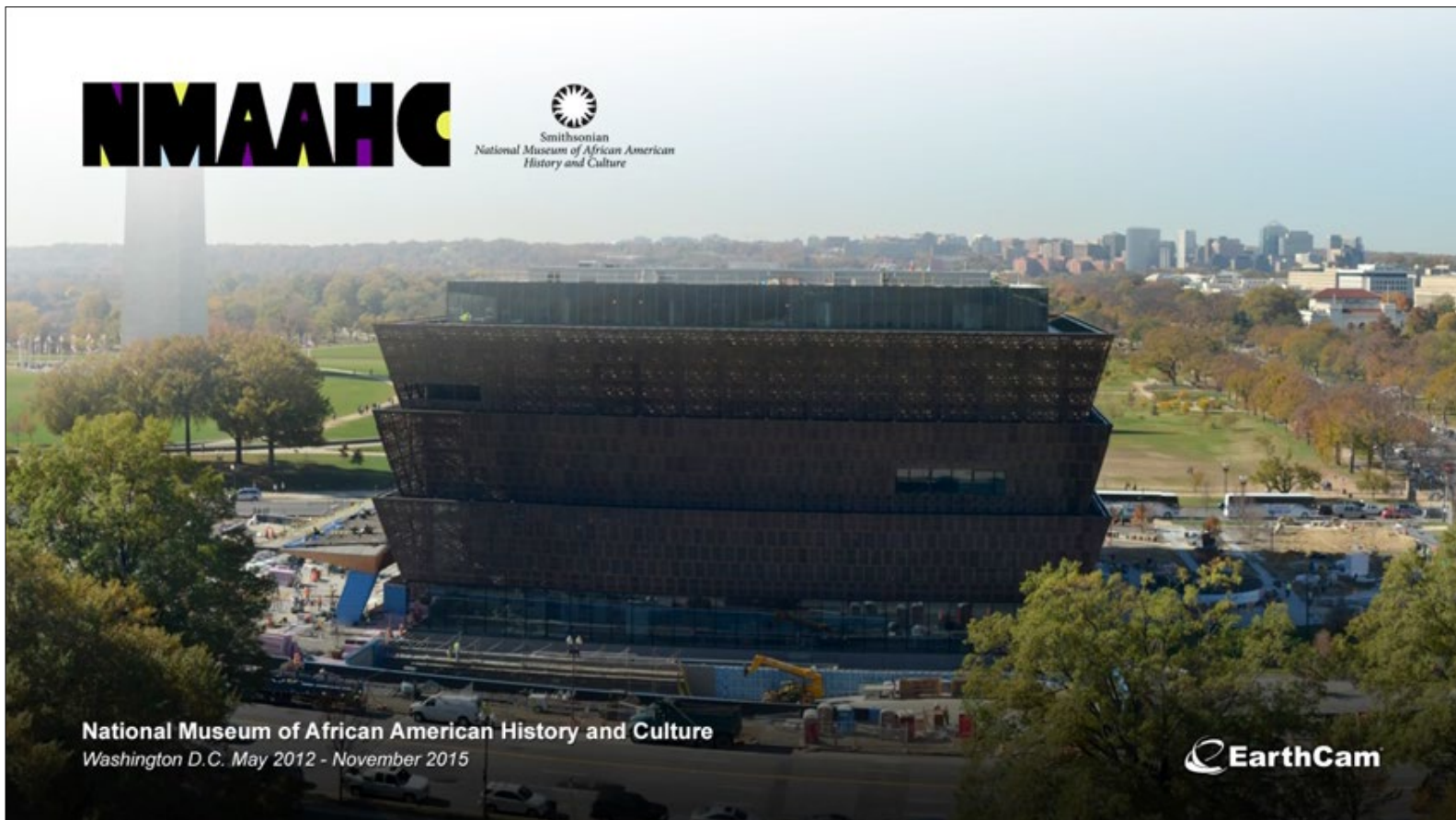
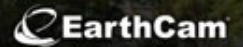


Timelapse Shows 52 Months of African American History Museum Construction (in 106 Seconds)
