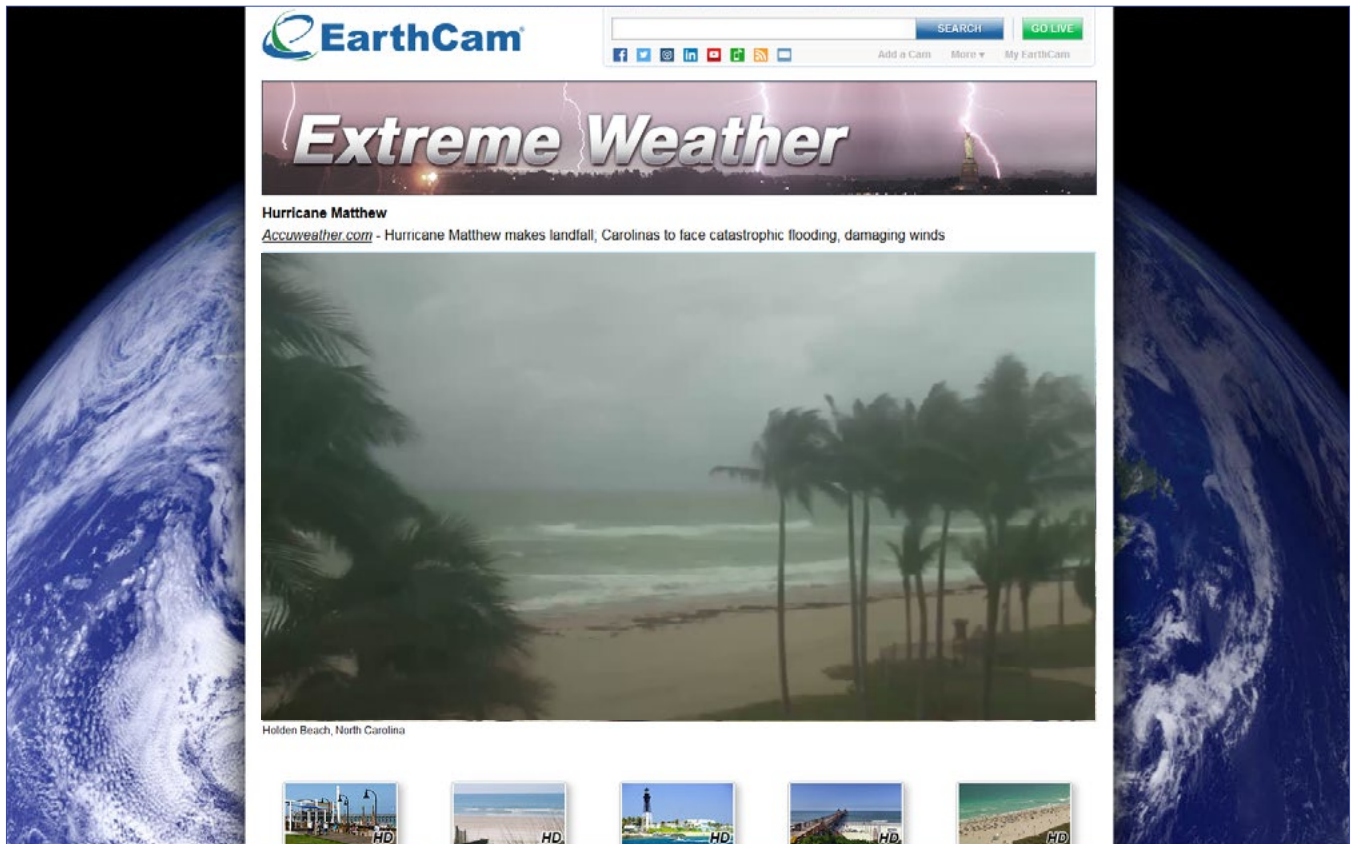


## Watch Hurricane Matthew approach U.S. coast live

AUGUSTA (WJBF) – As Hurricane Matthew continues to move closer to the southeastern coast of the United States, viewers can watch the storm as it happens via a network of live web cams placed up and down the coast courtesy of a handful of websites like [earthcam.com](http://earthcam.com) and [surflife.com](http://surflife.com).

As of Thursday afternoon, Matthew was a Category 4 storm located off the Florida coast. President Obama has declared a state of emergency for the Sunshine State and mandatory evacuations were also underway in Georgia and South Carolina.
