

See 29 months of 49ers' Levi's Stadium construction in one trippy video

A billion dollars, 7,000 construction workers and 29 months of building. It's no stretch to say the the San Francisco 49ers' new \$1.3 billion National Football League stadium in Silicon Valley was a massive undertaking.

Now, two months into operations at Levi's Stadium, video tech company [EarthCam](#) has released an "official time-lapse video" of all the action in Santa Clara, from groundbreaking in April 2012 to the team's September 2014 regular season home opener.

"It has been more than 50 years since an NFL stadium has been built in the state of California," said Niners' President Paraag Marathe in a statement. "We wanted to make sure we documented the project from every angle."
