See the five-year construction of UT Southwestern's new hospital in less two minutes

You've heard of saving time in a bottle. Now, you can see time at full throttle.

In the time-lapse video produced by [EarthCam](#) below, the 62-month construction project to build UT Southwestern's William P. Clements Jr. University Hospital is edited to under 2 minutes.

EarthCam used HD megapixel imagery to record the 1.3 million square-foot facility that was built from March 2011 to May 2016.

According to the UT Southwestern website, the 12-floor hospital has 460 patient rooms, 24 surgical suites and 72 adult ICU rooms.
