


WATCH: The New African American Museum Built In A Minute And A Half

WASHINGTON – The latest jewel in the Smithsonian's crown opens along the Mall on Saturday – the National Museum of African American History and Culture, but if you haven't snagged a ticket to get in, you'll be out of luck.
