

WATCH: Time-lapse shows expansion of the National Museum of the Marine Corps

TRIANGLE, Va. (ABC7) — Following the Fourth of July, [EarthCam](#) has released a time-lapse video of the expansion of the National Museum of the Marine Corps.

The expansion of the museum took just shy of two years, starting May, 2015 and ending this past April.

The newly added 115,000 square-foot space will house the Hall of Valor, Marine Corps Sports Gallery and Hall of Fame, as well as the Inter-war Gallery.

The museum, which resides near Quantico, opened November 2006.
