


Expedited: build a tower as high as Le Phare

(Quebec) Begun in 2014, construction of the 50 West Street continues in the financial district of Manhattan, near the World Trade Center. Occupancy expected: fall 2016.

Video produced by EarthCam can follow accelerated the progress of work from a point of view to the south of the tower.

At 64 stories and 780 feet, it will be the fourth highest residential tower in Manhattan. The same number of floors as multifunctional project in Quebec Le Phare. The comparison stops there.

The project offers 191 condos and penthouses capped with a private observation deck with BBQ, outdoor kitchen, etc.

Among the services to residents, a large swimming pool, saunas, a pet spa, workout rooms, a golf simulator, a library, a home theater, etc. It will also include some condos offices and a public square of 60,000 square feet connected to a gateway to Battery Park.
